RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM TO ESTABLISH A COMMODITY RESALE SYSTEM AND TO ENTER INTO A COMMODITY RESALE AGREEMENT WITH MENDHAM TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS, *N.J.A.C.* 5:34-7.15 authorizes contracting units to establish a Commodity Resale System; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey is desirous of establishing a Commodity Resale System for the resale of gasoline and diesel fuel; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mendham has agreed to serve as the Lead Agency for a Commodity Resale System with Mendham Township Board of Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on the March 24th 2020, by the Township Committee of Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Township Committee hereby authorizes the creation of a Commodity Resale System to be known as the Mendham Township Gasoline and Diesel Fuel Resale System with the Mendham Township Board of Education.
- 2. Mendham Township has agreed to serve as the Lead Agency for the Commodity Resale System with the Mendham Township Board of Education.
- 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Mendham Township Board of Education for the sale of gasoline and diesel fuel.
- 4. A single certified copy of this Resolution along with (1) a copy of the Purchase Agreement and (2) a copy of the Request for Registration or Modification of a Commodity Resale System Form (Cooperative Purchasing Form CP-2060) shall be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within the State Department of Community Affairs.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM APPROVING SETTLEMENTS OF REAL PROPERTY TAX APPEALS

WHEREAS, the municipal tax assessor and tax appeal counsel have negotiated settlements of real property tax appeals pending in the Tax Court of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the settlements are conditioned upon approval by the governing body of the Township of Mendham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, that the following proposed settlements are approved:

- 1. Block 100, Lot 27.04 2018 assessment to be reduced to \$2,200,000; 2019 assessment to be reduced to \$2,000,000, resulting in a total anticipated refund to the taxpayer in the amount of \$10,729.
- 2. Block 102, Lot 2.04 2018 assessment to be reduced to \$2,500,000; 2019 assessment to be reduced to \$2,263,700, resulting in a total anticipated refund to the taxpayer in the amount of \$18,954.63.
- 3. Block 112, Lot 7 2012 assessment to be reduced to \$1,750,000; 2013 assessment to be reduced to \$1,625,000; 2014 assessment to be reduced to \$1,500,000, resulting in a total anticipated refund to the taxpayer in the amount of \$20,064.63.
- 4. Block 127, Lot 74.05 2018 assessment to be reduced to \$1,750,000; 2019 assessment to be reduced to \$1,600,000, resulting in a total anticipated refund to the taxpayer in the amount of \$14,189.55.
- 5. Block 141, Lot 17 2018 assessment to be reduced to \$1,500,000; 2019 assessment to be reduced to \$1,500,000, resulting in a total anticipated refund to the taxpayer in the amount of \$12,730.95.
