WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

- (1) Matters Required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
- (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
- (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
- (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations of possible violations of the law.
- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose right could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.

Section 2. The several improvements hereby authorized are as follows:

Public Facilities: building repairs and septic alterations at Brookside Beach	\$25,000
DPW Equipment: Replacement truck and asphalt “hot box”	110,000
Rehabilitate / replace Salt Storage Shed	80,000
Road Infrastructure: Repairs / improvements various roads	120,000
Police Department: Video recorders and car cameras, computer upgrades	45,500
Recreation: Replacement of athletic field fencing	18,000
Fire Department: Equipment replacement	51,000
SCAB Replacement and Extraction Equipment	39,000

Section 3. The funding for the Various Improvements is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and adoption following passage and publication as provided by law and upon State approval and Township adoption of the 2021 Municipal Budget

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY,
AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 FOR THE
REASSESSMENT OF ALL PROPERTIES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM PURSUANT TO
N.J.S.A.40a:4-53 (b)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Local Budget Law of New Jersey, and in particular N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 (b), a special emergency appropriation in the amount of \$300,000 is hereby authorized and made for the purpose of the complete reassessment of properties in the Township of Mendham, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey.

Section 2. The Township of Mendham is hereby authorized to finance such appropriation from surplus funds available or by issuing special emergency notes from time to time in accordance with the provision of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55, all as shall be determined by and pursuant to a resolution or resolutions of the Township to be hereafter adopted. The authorization to finance the appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least 1/5 of the amount authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55.

Section 3. In accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, a copy of this ordinance as finally adopted shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final adoption, as provided by law.
